- Supervisor Entwistle stated most houses along that stretch are within the blue line. The house is already too close to the water according to the Canal Authority and this will make it a little closer. They want to take the deck off, add an addition and put the deck back on 8 or so feet. They are asking the setback for the addition be reduced from 100' to 29' from the mean high water and the 50' to 36' from the road boundary line.
