WHEREAS, there has recently been negative press coverage by the New York Times and some local papers within Oneida County suggesting that the Town court system is flawed and more specifically, alleging that the three hundred year tradition of non-lawyer judges presiding over and within the local municipalities should be eliminated; and

WHEREAS, there has always been a Town Court within the Town of Forestport, conveniently located and accessible to our citizens; and

WHEREAS, there is One (1) Town Judgeship established within the Town of Forestport, and

WHEREAS, there is presently One (1) non-attorney Town Justice within the Town of Forestport; and

WHEREAS, with their civil and criminal jurisdiction, the Town Justice in the Town of Forestport handled many hundreds of cases in the past year; and

WHEREAS, the Town Court of Forestport in the past year collected \$18,095.00 in statutory fines, fees and surcharges on behalf of the State of New York, the County of Oneida and the Town of Forestport, to help fund essential public services; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Forestport recognizes and appreciates the professionalism, diligence, intelligence and integrity of the non-attorney or lay justices within our town who bring a specialized experience to the bench particularly with issues unique to our community who elected them; and

Now, therefore, be it:

RESOLVED, that the members of the Town Board of Forestport support the continuation of the three hundred year tradition of non-lawyer or lay justices presiding in Town Courts, and it is further:

RESOLVED, that the members of the Town Board of Forestport hereby oppose any requirement that Town Justices be attorneys, and it is further;

RESOLVED, that the members of the Town Board of Forestport oppose any efforts to eliminate local and convenient access to justice by our citizens; and find that the local presence of the Town Court of Forestport provides a meaningful and necessary presence within our community for judicial resolution of conflicts, continued public safety of our citizens and the protection of constitutional guarantees for all of our citizens.
