When the contract is in, the board should check to make sure what amount the county is going to pay per mile. The soil and water meeting /workshop will be in Lee. Supervisor William Hasenauer and Linda Yancy went to the Oneida County meeting. Ritter is still working on the Grant for the boat launch, but if the town does not own the land there is not much that can be done until ownership occurs.

Councilman Brian Fox asked why the mower deck has not been returned to Evans tractor. Supervisor William Hasenauer said it has not been yet. Councilman Brian Fox reminded Hasenauer that he voted yes on sending it back at last month's Town Board meeting.

- Otter Lake has 3 radios that can be programmed to the 12.5 frequency, Woodgate fire has one.
- Forestport has none
- Highway is unsure of their current radio programming. All pagers all need to be changed too.
- All departments needs to make sure that radios later on can be programmed to 6.25 mega width which they may change in 2013.
- Trackside blazers are okay for now because they just purchased new radios
- All involved needs to do an inventory on radios and pagers
- There is no money for this from the state.
