2: Tonya Brown explained the exemption as follows:

The property receiving the exemption must be the primary residence of the veteran or his un-married surviving spouse. The veteran must have served active duty with United States armed forces during the time period from September 2, 1945 to December 26, 1991, was discharged under honorable conditions and had been on active duty for at least a year. The exemption is based on 15% of assessed value, but not exceeding \$12,000.00 in full assessment. The exemption is only on Town and County tax bills, not school tax bills. If a property owner is already receiving a veteran's exemption on his or her property, he or she does not qualify for this exemption.
