RESOLUTION FOR BLACK RIVER ENHANCEMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Town of Forestport, under its Black River Enhancement Project. Wishes to make improvements on its land and lands it also occupies owned by the New York State Canal Corporation, in the Town of Forestport, New York. WHEREAS, the project construction includes the re-construction of boat launches and parking area on two sites as follows: Location 1: Black River and Woodhull Road, owned by the NYS Canal Cop. Shall include a handicapped accessible boat launch, picnic and parking area, a boardwalk and fishing areas, effected area 1.3 acres, Location 2. River Road/Forestport Reservoir, owned by the NYS Canal Corp and the Town of Forestport shall include fishing access, rooftop boat access, picnic and parking area, effected area is about .77 acre.

WHEREAS, the Town of Forestport, as lead agency, has reviewed the proposed project pursuant to part 617.6 of

Implementing regulation pertaining to Article 8 (State Environmental Quality Review Act) of the Environmental Conservation law.

WHEREAS. In accordance with 6 NYCRR Part 617, an environmental evaluation has been performed as it relates to Forestport's Black River Enhancement Project the project, the actions described and to be undertaken is an Unlisted Action NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Board of the Town of Forestport that the Town of Forestport declares itself the Lead Agency and determines that the Black River Enhancement project is an Unlisted Action under 6 NYCRR Part 617 of the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) and acting as Lead Agency, directs Ward Associates, P.C. acting as its agent, to prepare materials and documents relating to the project for a coordinated review and to provide submission to all potentially involved agencies on its behalf.
