**CALL TO ORDER:**

The meeting was called to order at 6:25 pm by Supervisor Hasenauer.  
Councilman Seager read the legal notice.

Councilman Seager started discussion by stating that due to Hurricane Sandy, the State is pushing flood plain determination to a higher level. He reported that the town has the new flood plain maps. The read measurement for the maps is 1 inch= 1,000 feet. Councilman Seager reviewed the proposed law. He believes there should not be a set fee for a floodplain permit. The actual fee should be based on how much time and effort has been involved and how much money has been expended.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS AND CONCERNS WERE AS FOLLOWS:**

- Beth Roberts stated that insurance companies are now requiring flood elevations for policies. Discussion followed.
- Councilman Seager read the “Application for a Permit” portion of the proposed local law.
