Councilwoman Nancy Kardash stated that she was not happy with releasing Mr. Randall from his contract. Supervisor Parker Snead agreed that nobody was.

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Town has received an offer from JBA, LLC to purchase an 18.601 acre parcel of real property owned by the Town and located on North Lake Road in the Town of Forestport and,

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Town Board has determined that the real property is surplus property and that its sale to JBA, LLC is in the financial interest of the Town and,

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Town Board on October 5, 2015 held a public hearing concerning the sale to assess whether the sale of the real property was in the public interest of the residents of the Town and,

<u>WHEREAS</u>, The Town Board believes it should be the lead agency for the review of the sale to JBA, LLC (the "Action") under the New York Environmental Quality Act (SEQRA) since there are no other agencies that have authority to approve the action or are interested in the action and,

<u>WHEREAS</u>, The action appears to be an unlisted Action under SEQRA and the Town Board has caused drafts of Parts 1 and 2 of a short environmental assessment form (SEAF) to be prepared evaluating the environmental effects of the action, it is:

**RESOLVED,** That the Town Board designates the Town as the lead agency under SEQRA and Part 617 of the regulations implementing SEQRA; and it is further;

**RESOLVED**, That the Town Board of the Town of Forestport hereby determines that the project is an unlisted action pursuant to Part 617 of the regulations implementing SEQRA; and it is further;

**RESOLVED**, that the Town Board based on its review of Parts 1 and 2 of the SEAF determines that the project will have no significant adverse impacts on the environment and issues a negative declaration for the project and authorizes the Town Supervisor to execute Parts 1 and 3 of the SEAF; and it is further;

**RESOLVED** that the Town Supervisor is authorized to execute the sale/purchase agreement with JBA, LLC in the form presented to this special meeting of the Town Board and to execute an early possession agreement in the form presented to this special meeting of the Board allowing JBA, LLC to have early possession of the property pending the Town's compliance with the permissive referendum provisions of Section 90 of the Town Law and it is further;

**RESOLVED**, That the Town Clerk shall post and publish an abstract of the portion of this resolution authorizing sale of the real property to JBA, LLC in accordance with Town Law Section 90.
