# **OLD BUSINESS:**

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

• Buck Horn Association: Jack Dodson, Supervisor Entwistle and a majority of the people from the Buck Horn Association met two Saturday's ago. The Association expressed interest last September to establish a Water District. Jack inspected their water system and made preliminary findings. Supervisor Entwistle feels the Association will be at the July Meeting to ask the Board to pass a Resolution to create a Water District. If the Board does not create a Water District, the Association can pass a petition and if 50% of their membership's assessed value approves it, the Board will have to create a Water District. It breaks down the expected cost for the establishment and the cost in the foreseeable future. The map study would run \$5,000-\$6,000 and a contract will be made prior to it being done. If they decide to not move forward after finding out the cost, they will be responsible for the cost of the map study. If they move forward, the cost of the map study would be put into the loan from the USDA Rural Water Authority. The Association is having a Special Meeting regarding this in the coming weeks.
