

Resolution I

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Public Hearing will be held at
8:00 o'clock P.M. Wednesday, April 2, 1958, at Grover Block,
Forestport, New York, upon the following proposed ordinance:

*from automatic
equipment*

1. That no oil or kerosene may be offered or delivered for retail sale and consumption in the Town of Forestport unless the measure of the quantity of the delivery is automatically made and printed and stamped on the delivery slip by automatic recordation on the delivery equipment at the point or place of retail delivery.

2. Any violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof be punishable by fine not exceeding One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each such offense, or by imprisonment in the County Jail, or by both such fine and imprisonment; that upon failure to pay any such fine, imprisonment in the County Jail until such fine be paid, not to exceed one day for each \$1.00 of the fine imposed.

3. This ordinance will take effect *July 1, 1958* ~~in accordance with and upon compliance with the terms and conditions of article 9 of the Town Law of the State of New York.~~
