

RESOLUTION FOR CONTROL OF SNOW AND ICE ON COUNTY ROADS

WHEREAS, The town of Forestport, County of Oneida, State of New York, entered into agreement on the 1st day of December 1965, with the County of Oneida for Control of Snow and Ice on the County Road System of Highways within the town as designated by the Deputy Commissioner of the Oneida County Department of Public Works, Division of Highways & Bridges, in accordance with the terms, rules and regulations as set forth by the Agreement, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Town Superintendent and Supervisor of the above named town are hereby authorized and directed to extend said Agreement for the year or winter of 1966 - 1967; subject to the approval of the Deputy Commissioner of Public Works for the County.

AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF ONEIDA AND THE TOWN OF FORESTPORT

FOR CONTROL OF SNOW AND ICE ON COUNTY ROADS.

(Pursuant to Resolution of the Board of Supervisors)

THIS AGREEMENT, made this 1 day of Dec. 1965 by and between the County of Oneida, hereinafter called "County" acting through John W. COLE, Deputy Commissioner, County Department of public works, and the town of Forestport, county of Oneida, State of New York.

WITNESSETH: that for the consideration and upon the terms and conditions hereinafter provided the Town agrees to furnish all machinery, labor and materials therefor and to keep the paved portion of the highways herein described free from snow and ice in accordance with the rules and regulations as set forth by the County and which are made a part of this contract for the snow season dating from about Nov. 1 through March 31 of each year as resolution is passed by Town Board,

IT IS FURTHER AGREED that the Town shall keep the County insured against liability incurred in these operations by carrying Liability Insurance on all automotive equipment certificate of such insurance must be placed on file in the County office by November 15, each year, in the following amounts:

Bodily injury: \$100,000 ea. person, \$300,000 ea. accident,
Property damage: \$50,000 ea. accident, \$500,000 aggregate,
and shall save the County from all claims for labor or materials used on this contract.
