1. The signs and posts shall be furnished by the Town of Forestport

2. The type of signs shall be in accordance with the Manual of Uniform
Traffic Control Devices-State of New York-State Traffic Commission.
3. The erection of the sign shall be by: Oneida County D.P.W.
4. Maintenance of the signs shall be by the Town of Forestport
~~or by private contractor~~
Failure to properly maintain ANY or ALL of the signs shall constitute
warrant for their ENTIRE removal in accordance with Section 103-a
of the Highway Law. (Improper Maintenance constitutes illegibility,
not plumb, improper height or distance, missing signs, replacement
with wrong type, etc.)
5. This permit shall be declared NOT VALID unless a copy of the Town
Board Resolution in accordance with Article 41, Section 1660, Sub-
division 18 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law is filed with the Oneida
County Department of Public Works. Application for this permit shall
precede the Town Board Resolution.
