RESOLUTION FINDING THE ADJACENT TOWN HIGHWAY BRIDGES USELESS AND NOT NECESSARY FOR THE PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND WELFARE, AND RECOMMENDING THAT ONEIDA COUNTY ABANDON THE BRIDGES IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 231, SUBDIVISION 12 OF THE HIGHWAY LAW.

- The adjacent bridges, Bridge No. 10 T-7 B.I.N. 2205710 WHEREAS, with a span of twenty-four feet and Bridge No. 10 T-8 B.I.N. 2205720 with a span of sixty-six feet across the Big Woodhull Creek on the town highway known as Meekerville Road in the Town of Forestport, extending from Woodhull Street easterly to Meekerville Road South, have become useless and are not necessary for the public convenience and welfare, and
- The general condition of the said bridges has deterio-WHEREAS. rated to the extent that repairs to the structures are not feasible, and
- Access to Woodhull Street and Meekerville Road South is WHEREAS. provided by adjacent highways, now, therefore, be it hereby,
- That pursuant to Highway Law Section 231 Subdivision RESOLVED, 12, the Town Board of the Town of Forestport finds that the bridges over the Big Woodhull Creek, identified as Bridge No. 10 T-7, B.I.N. 2205710, having a span of twenty-four (24) feet and Bridge No. 10 T-8 B.I.N. 2205720 having a span of sixty-six (66) feet, located on the town highway known as Meekerville Road, have become useless and are not necessary for the public convenience and welfare, and be it further
- That the Town Board recommends that Oneida County RESOLVED, abandon the said bridges in accordance with Section 231, Subdivision 12 of the highway law.
