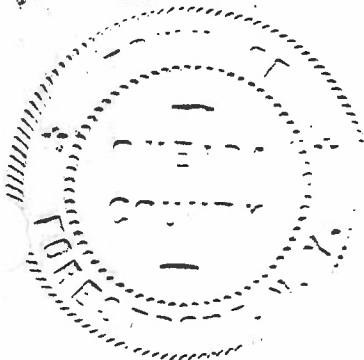

RESTRICTING OPERATION OF RECREATIONAL VEHICLES

LOCAL LAW NO. 1--1985

At a Regular Meeting of the Forestport Town Board held at the Town Building, Forestport, New York, on the 14th day of August, 1985 the following local law was duly passed and enacted:

I. THIS LOCAL LAW RESTRICTS THE OPERATION OF:

Motorcycles, unlicensed off the road vehicles, unenclosed limited use vehicles having only two or three wheels, four-wheel recreational vehicles, and all, "limited use all-terrain vehicles." This local law shall not apply to a tractor, nor to a snowmobile.

II. IT IS DECLARED TO BE UNLAWFUL:

For any of the aforesaid vehicles to be operated by anyone, regardless of his age, anywhere in the Town of Forestport, in such a manner so as to create loud, unnecessary or unusual noise, so as to disturb or interfere with the peace and tranquility of other persons, and it shall be further unlawful for anyone, regardless of age, to operate said vehicles so as to endanger or be likely to endanger the safety or property of any persons, including the operator of said vehicle.

III. NONE OF SAID VEHICLES SHALL BE OPERATED AT ANYTIME ON ANY LANDS LEASED, OWNED OR CONTROLLED BY THE TOWN OF FORESTPORT, INCLUDING TOWN HIGHWAYS.

Except in the event of specific authority from the Town Board of the Town of Forestport, or officials of the Town of Forestport duly authorized by the Town Board in such regard.

~~IV. IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL:~~

For anyone, regardless of age, who operates any of the aforesaid vehicles, whether it be on property of the operator or not, and regardless of his age, ~~without carrying proof of adequate liability insurance covering said vehicle.~~

PENALTY

ANY VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS LOCAL LAW SHALL BE DEEMED A VIOLATION, AND THE VIOLATOR SHALL BE SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$500.00, OR IMPRISONMENT FOR A TERM NOT EXCEEDING 15 DAYS, OR BOTH. FURTHER, ANY ENFORCEMENT OFFICER HEREINAFTER DESIGNATED, WHO SHALL ENCOUNTER ANY PERSON OPERATING ANY SUCH VEHICLE IN VIOLATION OF THIS LOCAL LAW, SHALL REMOVE SAID VEHICLE TO A PLACE DESIGNATED BY THE FORESTPORT TOWN BOARD, OR ITS DULY AUTHORIZED OFFICIALS, WITH THE OWNER OR DULY DESIGNATED AGENT OF THE OWNER OF SUCH VEHICLE BEING ABLE TO REGAIN SAME UPON PAYMENT OF EXPENSES AND CHARGES NECESSARILY AND ACTUALLY INCURRED BY THE REMOVAL OF SAID VEHICLE. IN THE CASE OF A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT VIOLATION, THE COURT SHALL HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO ORDER CONFISCATION OF SAID VEHICLES IN LIEU OF ANY FINE AND/OR IMPRISONMENT, OR IN ADDITION THERETO. ANY VEHICLE WHICH IS CONFISCATED PURSUANT TO THIS ORDINANCE WILL BE SOLD AT PUBLIC AUCTION ACCORDING TO THE APPROPRIATE PROCEDURES AND LAW AFFECTING PUBLIC AUCTION BY MUNICIPALITIES.

MEMBERS OF THE NEW YORK STATE POLICE, THE SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT OF ONEIDA COUNTY, AND TOWN OF FORESTPORT CONSTABLES ARE HEREBY AUTHORIZED TO ENFORCE AND CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS LOCAL LAW.

This Local Law shall supervene to the extent it conflicts with any prior Recreational Vehicle Ordinance.

#### **LEGAL NOTICE**

Notice is hereby given that there will be a **Public Hearing** by the town board of the Town of Forestport, New York at the town hall, on **Wednesday, February 5, 1975 at 8 p.m. D.S.T.** upon the following proposed Town Ordinance:

#### **SNOWMOBILE ORDINANCE**

The Town Board of the Town of Forestport hereby designates all roads in the Town of Forestport, for operation of snowmobiles as contained in the Parks and Recreation Law. Whereas: The Town Board of the Town of Forestport requires all snowmobiles operating on the town roads in the Town of Forestport must carry Insurance comparable to New York State Motor Vehicles. **Speed Limits:** Snowmobiles operating on the roads of the Town of Forestport shall not exceed at any time 20 m.p.h. All snowmobiles operating on the roads of the Town of Forestport are required to have adequate mufflers. All other laws of this Ordinance will be pursuant to New York State Snowmobile Law. Any violations of this article will be pursuant to New York State Snowmobile Law.

The regular Town Board meeting was held at the Town Hall on February 5, 1975 at 8 p.m. Town Board members present were Supervisor Howard Parsons - Justice Dewey Lyon, Paul Rose - Councilmen Richard Sears, Lawrence Rittle - Attorney James P. O'Rourke absent.

Meeting opened with a public hearing of the proposed snowmobile Ordinance - opening Town Roads for snowmobiling. Motion made by Paul Rose - to adopt Snowmobile Ordinance. Motion includes cost of opening roads - for insurance and road signs not to exceed cost of \$1,500. Motion second by Dewey Lyon. Roll call vote:
