

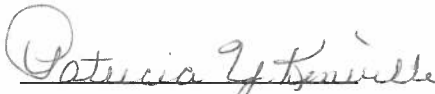
R E S O L U T I O N

THIS LOCAL LAW HEREBY AMENDS LOCAL LAW NO. 1 FOR 1987 AS FOLLOWS:
SECTION 3.2 BASIS FOR ESTABLISHING THE AREAS OF SPECIAL FLOOD HAZARD

The areas of special flood hazard have been identified by the Federal Emergency Management Agency on Flood Insurance Rate Maps enumerated on Map Index No. 360529B 01-11 dated April 17, 1985.
