RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on the 15th day of August, 1990, an extension of the Oneida County Sales and Use Tax for an additional two year period from December 1, 1990 to November 30, 1992 for the County of Oneida was passed by the Oneida County Board of Legislators, and

WHEREAS, said resolution, as well as Section 1262 (c) of the Tax

Law provides that all cities, villages and towns within the County

of Oneida may elect by resolution to receive a direct payment of the

amounts which would otherwise be applied to reduce County taxes and

general taxes upon real property in such towns, cities or villages, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Forestport has elected to be paid directly as provided for in said Resolution and as provided for in Section 1262 (c) of the Tax Law of the State of New York, now, therefore, be it hereby

RESOLVED, by the Town of Forestport, New York, that any and all proceeds from the sales tax imposed by the County of Oneida which are allocated to the Town of Forestport, be paid directly to the Town of Forestport, pursuant to Section 1262(c) of the Tax Law and also pursuant to the Resolution 212 of the County of Oneida imposing a county sales tax, and it is further

RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall only be effective if it is mailed by registered or certified mail to the County Comptroller, chief fiscal officer of the County of Oneida, and shall remain in effect until it is rescinded according to law. In the event of further extensions of this tax, no further resolutions of this type will be required in future years.
