A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE AND SALE OF SERIAL BONDS IN A PRINCIPAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$93,000.00 OF THE TOWN OF FORESTPORT, COUNTY OF ONEIDA AND STATE OF NEW YORK PURSUANT TO THE LOCAL FINANCE LAW OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK FOR THE PURPOSE OF FINANCING A WASTE WATER COLLECTION AND TREATMENT SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, by Resolution and Order of this Board dated

January 23, 1991, the Town authorized the creation of a special

district to be known as the Town of Forestport Sanitary Sewer

District No. 1 (the "District") and authorizing the expenditure of

up to ONE MILLION DOLLARS (\$1,000,000) for the construction of a

waste water collection and treatment system to benefit the

residents of the District; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to §231 of the Town Law of the State of New York the Town is authorized to issue obligations to finance the cost of such improvements and to assess the owners of the property in said District to pay such obligations; and

WHEREAS, it appears that the total estimated project cost for the waste water collection and treatment system in the amount of NINE HUNDRED THRITY CONTHOUSAND DOLLARS (\$931,000.00), being within the amount authorized by order of this Board and for which assessment may be made;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE TOWN OF FORESTPORT, County of Oneida, State of New York, as follows:

- 1. There are hereby authorized to be issued Serial Bonds of the Town of Forestport, County of Oneida, State of New York, pursuant to the Local Finance Law of the State of New York, said Serial Bonds to be in an amount not exceeding the principal amount of Nine HUNDREDTHIRTH-ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$431,000.00), for the specific object or purpose of funding the Town's installation of a waste water collection and treatment system for the Town of Forestport Sanitary Sewer District No. 1.
- 2. The maximum estimated cost of financing of a waste water collection and treatment system is \$931,000.00. The total maximum estimated cost of the aforestated objects or purposes is \$931,000.00. The plan for financing thereof is through the issuance of serial bonds of the Town, as authorized hereunder, in an amount not to exceed \$350,000.00. The serial bonds authorized hereunder are to be payable from amounts which shall annually be levied upon all of the taxable real property within the District, and the full faith and credit of the Town of Forestport, County of Oneida, State of New York, are hereby pledged for the payment of said bonds and the interest thereupon.
- 3. It is hereby determined that the aforesaid specific object or purpose falls within Section 11.00(a)(4) of the Local Finance Law of the State of New York and that the period of probable usefulness of such object or purpose is forty years.

- 4. Subject to the relevant provisions of the Local Finance Law, the power to authorize the issuance and to sell bond anticipation notes, in anticipation of the issuance and sale of the serial bonds authorized herein, including the renewal of such notes, is hereby delegated to the Supervisor of the Town Board, the Town's Chief Fiscal Officer. The bonds or bond anticipation notes authorized herein shall be of such terms, form and content, and shall be sold in such manner as may be prescribed by said Supervisor of the Town Board, consistent with the relevant provisions of the Local Finance Law, and shall be in a principal amount not to exceed \$931,000.00. The serial bonds authorized herein, and the bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation thereof, shall contain substantially the recital of validity clause provided for in Section 52.00 of the Local Finance Law and shall otherwise be in such form and contain such recitals, in addition to those required by Section 51.00 of the Local Finance Law, as the Supervisor of the Town Board shall determine.
- 5. The validity of the bonds and the bond anticipation notes authorized hereunder may be contested only if:
- such obligations are authorized for an object or purpose for which the Town of Forestport is not authorized to spend money; or
- 2) the provisions of the law which should be complied with as of the date of publication of this resolution are not substantially complied with, and an action, suit or proceeding

contesting such validity is commenced within twenty (20) days after the date of such publication; or

- 3) such obligations are authorized in violation of the provisions of the Constitution of the State of New York.
- 6. There are no bond anticipation notes currently outstanding which have been previously issued in anticipation of the serial bonds.
- 7. The bond anticipation notes authorized hereunder are not renewal bond anticipation notes and are not issued in anticipation of the sale of serial bonds for an assessable improvement.
- 8. A summary of this resolution shall be published in the official newspaper or newspapers of the Town, together with a notice from the Town Clerk, substantially in the form provided in Section 81.00 of the Local Finance Law.
- 9. The bond anticipation notes authorized hereunder shall mature one year from the date of issue.
 - 10. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
