

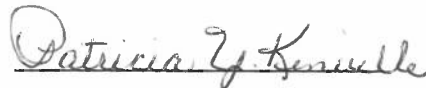
R E S O L U T I O N

The Supervisor put the resolution to vote with the following results:

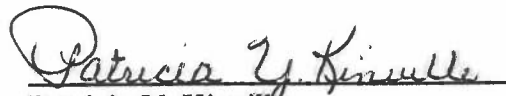
