

RESOLUTION

AT A SPECIAL MEETING of The Town Board of the Town of Forestport held on Wednesday, February 2, 1995 at the Town Offices located on Woodhull Street in the Town of Forestport, the following resolution was made by Councilwoman Joan Ingersoll and seconded by Councilman John Norton;

WHEREAS the Town of Forestport has been required to close West River Street in the Town because of the condition of the bridge spanning the Black River; and

WHEREAS as a result of the closure there is increased traffic on New York State Route 28, including snowmobile traffic which creates a danger to the public; and

WHEREAS as a result the Town Board believes that there is a public emergency which requires the bridge to be repaired for the safety of the inhabitants of the Town of Forestport and that therefore repairs to the bridge need to be made immediately and cannot await competitive bidding.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Town of Forestport enter into a contract with Tuscarora Construction Co., Inc. to make repairs to the decking and undercarriage of the bridge spanning the Black River on West River Street in the Town of Forestport; and

2. The Town of Forestport pay to Tuscarora Construction Co., Inc. a sum not to exceed Twenty-Five Thousand (\$25,000.00) Dollars for the repairs made pursuant to a contract to be executed by the Town of Forestport and Tuscarora Construction Co., Inc.; and

3. The Town Board hereby authorizes the Town Supervisor, Russell J. Hirschey, to execute the contract with Tuscarora Construction Co., Inc. on behalf of the Town subject to the final approval of its terms by the Town attorney and the New York State Department of Transportation.
