FAIR HOUSING MONTH: MARCH 1995

- WHEREAS, federal and New York State laws prohibit discrimination in the sale, rental and financing of housing because of race, creed, color or previous condition of servitude; and,
- WHEREAS, 1995 commemorates the 27th anniversary of the 1968 Fair Housing Act prohibiting discrimination in housing because of race, color, sex, national origin, religion, handicap, or familial status; and,
- WHEREAS, the legislation has provided protection to the citizenry and furthered the interests of the nation by allowing citizens to obtain lodgings and homes on the basis of their aspirations and economic abilities and by reducing the tensions that occur when people are deprived of fair housing opportunities; and,

- WHEREAS, the National Association of Realtors have signed a Voluntary Affirmative Marketing Agreement to implement provisions of fair housing laws; and,
- WHEREAS, it is important to commemorate the passage of the Fair Housing Act of 1968 as amended;
